REVERSING THE IRREVERSABLE

INTRODUCTION

John 8:3-5 <u>Then the scribes and Pharisees brought to Him a woman caught in adultery.</u> And when they had set her in the midst, they said to Him, Teacher, this woman was caught^[2] in adultery, in the very act. Now Moses, in the law, commanded^[3] us that such should be stoned.^[4] But what do You say?[[]

The rulers were right taking the adulterous woman to Jesus to condemn her under the written law saying

Exo 20:14 "You shall not commit adultery.

Jesus quoting the law said,

1. The Accused

"<u>And when they had set her in the midst"...</u>.... NO defense but guilty, JUST WAITING FOR THE JUSTICE SYSTEM TO PRONOUCE GUILTY

2. Guilty as charged.

"This woman was caught in adultery, in the very act"......

• Pro 8:36 But he who sins against me wrongs his own soul; All those who hate me love death.

- Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin is death,...
- Psa 102:20, To release those appointed to death,.....

3. <u>DEATH SENTENCE</u>

The sentence under the law irreversible-<u>Now Moses, in the law, commanded us that such should be stoned......</u> Because is written is written

- Heb 9:27 And as it is appointed for men to die once,....
- Eze 18:20 The soul who sins shall die. The son shall not bear the guilt of the father, nor the father bear the guilt of the son. The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself.
- 2Co 1:9 Yes, we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves but in God who raises the dead,

4. The hope of salvation

The hope of deliverance is what the judge will say

"But what do you say?".....

- John 3:17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.
- John 4:50-53 Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way.

And as he was now going down, his servants met him and told him, saying, Thy son liveth.

Then inquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him.

So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house.

5. The accusers also guilty

John 8:7 So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up and said to them, He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first

Rom 3:19

Now we know that whatever the law says, it says to those who are under the law that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God.

6. The justice system is full of oppression-

"this woman was caught in adultery, in the very act"......

Ecc 4:1 Then I returned and considered all the oppression that is done under the sun: And look! The tears of the oppressed, But they have no comforter--On the side of their oppressors there is power, But they have no comforter.

I sa 5:7 For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts is the house of I srael, And the men of Judah are His pleasant plant. He looked for justice, but behold, oppression; For righteousness, but behold, a cry for help.

7. THE HELPER.

John 8:7-10

<u>So when they continued asking Him, He raised Himself up ^[7] and said to</u> them, He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first. And again He stooped down and wrote on the ground. Then those who heard it, being convicted by their conscience,^[8] went out one by one, beginning with the oldest even to the last. And Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.

When Jesus had raised Himself up and saw no one but the woman, He said to her,^[9] Woman, where are those accusers of yours?^[10] Has no one condemned you?

This will be written for the generation to come, That a people yet to be created may praise the LORD. For He looked down from the height of His sanctuary; From heaven the LORD viewed the earth, To hear the groaning of the prisoner, To release those appointed to death, To declare the name of the LORD in Zion,

And His praise in Jerusalem,

May the LORD answer you in the day of trouble; May the name of the God of Jacob defend you; May He send you help from the sanctuary, And strengthen you out of Zion;

• Psa 82:3 **Defend** the poor and fatherless; Do justice to the afflicted and needy.

8. JESUS THE ADVOCATE

"He said to her, Woman, where are those accusers of yours? Has no one condemned you"

9. JESUS THE JUDGE

"He who is without sin among you, let him throw a stone at her first"

Psa 82:1-4

God stands in the congregation of the mighty;

He judges among the gods.^[1]

How long will you judge unjustly,

And show partiality to the wicked? Selah

Defend the poor and fatherless;

Do justice to the afflicted and needy.

Deliver the poor and needy; free them from the hand of the wicked.

Rom 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,

10. <u>JESUS THE DELIVER</u>

And again He stooped down and wrote on the ground. Then those who heard it, being convicted by their conscience,^[8] went out one by one, beginning with the oldest even to the last. And Jesus was left alone, and the woman standing in the midst.

1. The finger of God

"But Jesus stooped down and wrote on the ground with His finger, as though He did not hear."

• Re-Wrote the law-

Exo 31:18 And when He had made an end of speaking with him on Mount Sinai, He gave Moses two tablets of the Testimony, tablets of stone, written with the finger of God.

Eph 2:15 having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace,

• Destroying thrones-

Dan 5:4-5 They drank wine, and praised the gods of gold and silver, bronze and iron, wood and stone. In the same hour the **fingers** of a man's hand appeared and wrote opposite the lampstand on the plaster of the wall of the king's palace; and the king saw the part of the hand that wrote.

Casting out devils-

Luke 13:32 And He said to them, Go, tell that fox, "Behold, I cast out demons and perform cures today and tomorrow, and the third day I shall be perfected."

Luke 11:20 But if I cast out demons with the **finger** of God, surely the kingdom of God has come upon you.

• Destroying the works of satan-

Exo 8:19 Then the magicians said to Pharaoh, This is the finger of God. But Pharaoh's heart grew hard, and he did not heed them, just as the LORD had said.

"And again He stooped down and wrote on the ground"

- Deliver from death-
 - Gen 3:19 In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread Till you return to the ground, For out of it you were taken;

For dust you are, And to dust you shall return.

Gen 3:23 Therefore the LORD God sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken.

Gen 3:14 So the LORD God said to the serpent: Because you have done this, You are cursed more than all cattle, And more than every beast of the field; On your belly you shall go, And you shall eat dust All the days of your life.

Solution-

Heb 2:9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.

Heb 2:15 and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage

THE HEARING-

Rev 3:13 He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

"Then those who heard it_"

Act 2:4,7,8 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. Then they were all amazed and marveled, saying to one another, Look, are not all these who speak Galileans And how is it that we hear, each in our own language in which we were born?

CONVICTION OF SIN-

" being convicted by their conscience,"

John 16:7-11 Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of

righteousness, and of judgment: of sin, because they do not believe in Me; of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

LET HER ALONE - "went out one by one, beginning with the oldest even to the last."

John 12:7 But Jesus said, Let her alone; -----.

Mar 1:24 saying, Let us alone! What have we to do with You, Jesus of Nazareth? Did You come to destroy us? I know who You are--the Holy One of God!

2. The spoken word

The voice of the son-Psalms 29:3-9

• Vs. 3 The VOICE of the Lord is upon the waters: the God of glory thundereth; the Lord is upon many waters.-

The VOICE of the Lord shall thunder over and against every water of affliction that has flooded your life and has troubled you uptil now. The VOICE of the Lord will seat on those waters. They will no longer overwhelm you for His glory shall be your defense.

• Vs. 4 The VOICE of the Lord is POWERFUL; the VOICE of the Lord is FULL of MAJESTY.

This scripture says that the VOICE of God is full of power, full of strength and full of ability. His VOICE will fight for you, it will defend you, it will work for you and position you for the best He has prepared for you. His VOICE is also full of MAJESTY, full of splendor and glory. In your new year, the VOICE of the Lord will speak for you in high places. Places you were not qualified to go or enter and in turn bring His glory and beauty upon you.

- .5 The VOICE of the Lord BREAKETH the cedars; yea the Lord breaketh the cedars of Lebanon. The cedars of Lebanon is a very strong and hard wood. For its strength great kings used it to build the palaces. If the VOICE of the Lord can break the hardest wood according to the scripture, it will all also break and destroy every yoke in your life. It will destroy any chain in your hands and legs and set you free for 2010. Any tree that is not planted by my father shall be uprooted.
- Vs. 6 He MAKETH them also to SKIP like a calf; Lebanon and Sirion like a young unicorn.

Sirion is called Mount Hermon. If mountains can skip like a calf and young unicorn or wild Ox, therefore in 2010 every mountain before you will also skip like a calf and wild Ox from your presence and buried in the sea.

• Vs.7 The VOICE of the Lord DIVIDETH the flames of fire.

The VOICE of God will divide and split the flames of fire set by your enemies. It will scatter the lightening and its flashes preventing its terror targeted against you and keep them far from you. The fire will not kindle upon you anymore.

- vs.8 The VOICE of the Lord SHAKETH the wilderness; the Lord SHAKETH the wilderness of Kadesh. The VOICE of God will cause your wilderness to tremble and release you. It will release everything it has swallowed up that belongs to you. Your wilderness will shake and the things that are not of God in your life will be shaken off. You will walk out of your wilderness, even the wilderness of your village and household evil and walk into your greatness.
- Vs.9 The VOICE of the Lord MAKETH the hinds to calve, and discovereth the forest: and in His temple doth every one speak of His glory. If the VOICE of the Lord can make the hinds to bring forth their young, then you will give birth to every potential you carry on the inside of you in 2010. The gifts of God in you will be birthed in this new year. In discovering your forest; you will discover your area of assignment and your your place of calling, then whatever you are carrying on the inside of you will be manifested and they will make a way for you. And in the congregation of the saints of God shall His people gather and give God all the glory for your life; saying that the VOICE of the Lord has done this.
